Driving from Vancouver

- Go Southbound on Granville Street then merge onto the Arthur Laing Bridge
- Take a slight right at Grant McConachie Way
- Take ramp to Richmond / South Terminal
- Merge onto Russ Baker Way
- Turn right at Inglis Drive
- Travel approximately 1.5 km until you see the second Seaplane Dock and building along the waters edge. Our building has a teal green roof with windsock on top

Driving from Richmond

- Proceed Northbound over the No. 2 Road Bridge onto Russ Baker Way
- Take the frst left onto Inglis Drive
- Travel approximately 1.5 km until you see the second Seaplane Dock and building along the waters edge. Our building has a teal green roof with windsock on top



From the Vancouver International Airport Main Terminal: 10 minutes away

Upon arrival at the Vancouver Airport take a taxi and ask the driver to take you to the Seair Seaplane Terminal which is located on the Southside of the Vancouver International Airport.
